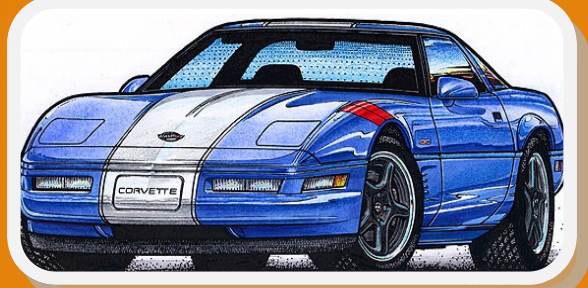
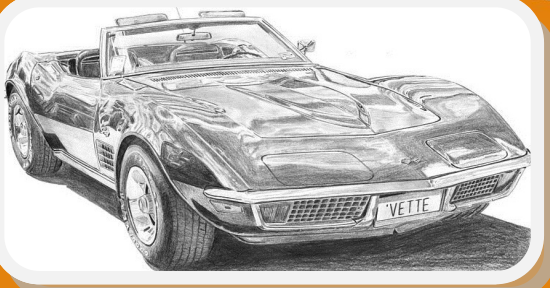

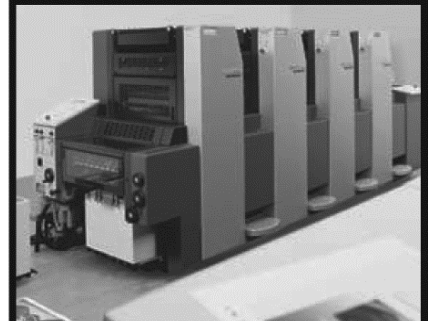

CORVETTE®

FIFTY  YEARS



RANDY LEFFINGWELL

First published in 2003 this is not nor was intended to be a definitive history or year by year account of the corvette. It is more an account of the struggle to create and then continue the production of the corvette.

Officially sanctioned by GM the author was allowed access into their archives in Detroit to select photographs for the book, as he himself declares many that appear in it have never been published before. This is another very unwieldy volume its sheer size and shape making it a difficult read 31 x 28 x 4 and 384 pages make it quite hefty. Author Randy Leffingwell is the author and photographer of Mustang: Forty Years, American Muscle, and Hot Wheels: 35 Years of Speed, Power, Performance, and Attitude. He was a former staff photographer and writer with the Los Angeles Times. He is also responsible for many of the photographs within the book. Here in is the real strength and sheer pleasure of this book, simply put many of these original photographs are stunning. Leffingwell and co photographer David Newhardt have an eye for details and fresh angles on

our favourite vehicle.

The author intertwines his tales of the struggles within GM and the development of the vehicle with out one over powering the other, Leffingwell pulls out memorable quotes, such as this 1986 gem from Chevrolet's chief engineer Don Runkle; "We could obviously build a \$100,000 Corvette and blow away the [Ferrari] Testarossa, but I'm not sure what the point of that exercise is. That just shows that you can do it. Our goal is to do it at 25 percent of the price."



The book is in very large print (I could read it without my glasses !) and there are more photographs than you can shake a stick at which isn't a bad thing, the book is split into eleven chapters commencing with back ground and a general synopsis from here its goes into the pre production and development of the show car that stopped a nation. The following chapter covers 53 to 55 and some rare beasts thrown in for good measure, like the Nomad wagon and Ghia Aigle (re bodied 54) styled to imitate a Ferrari 250GT. All of the subsequent chapters cover two or three



years of development and production, some with a focus more on the people that influenced or built the corvette or the races that helped establish her credentials. Some of the names in here are a mystery to me and will require further research for possible articles. Chapter 8 then brakes from as we have reached 1968 and the C3 so we flow through till 1982. C4's are split into two chapters 83 till 89 and then 90 to 96 with the final chapter covering 1997 until 2003.



This book offers a very different perspective on corvettes history and definitely increased my knowledge of stupid facts, did you know that Carroll Shelby originally offered his concept of the off the shelf street racer to Chevrolet as a possible offering from the vette stable and was turned down flat. The idea spurned by Gary Laughlin a Texan oil man and chevy dealer and Jim Hall a fellow racer and car enthusiast when the 3 shipped three 1959's to Scaglietti in Italy who were producing Ferrari bodies and had custom light weight bodies fitted.. The goal was to go racing but this never eventuated and the cars are now collectors pieces/

Okay so would I buy this book: No for the simple reason that is has already been re released and retitled 'Corvette 60 Years' which came out earlier this year and can be purchased from Amazon.com for the princely sum of \$32.. If you are going to purchase it be aware that there are four editions all with different covers and different inside jacket photographs.

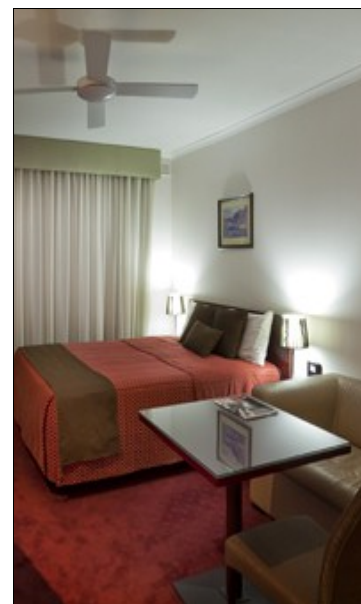
