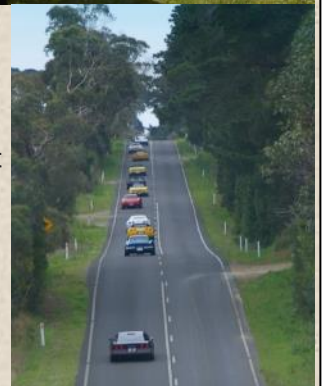

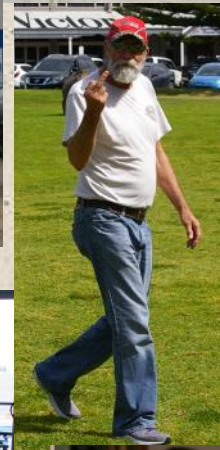

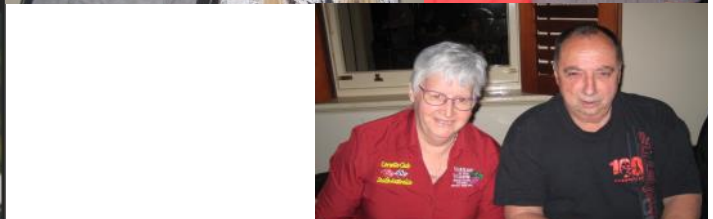
Largs Pier—Dinner

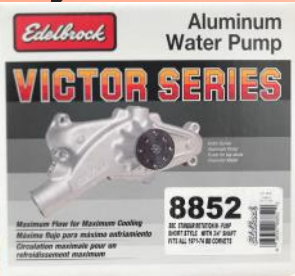
