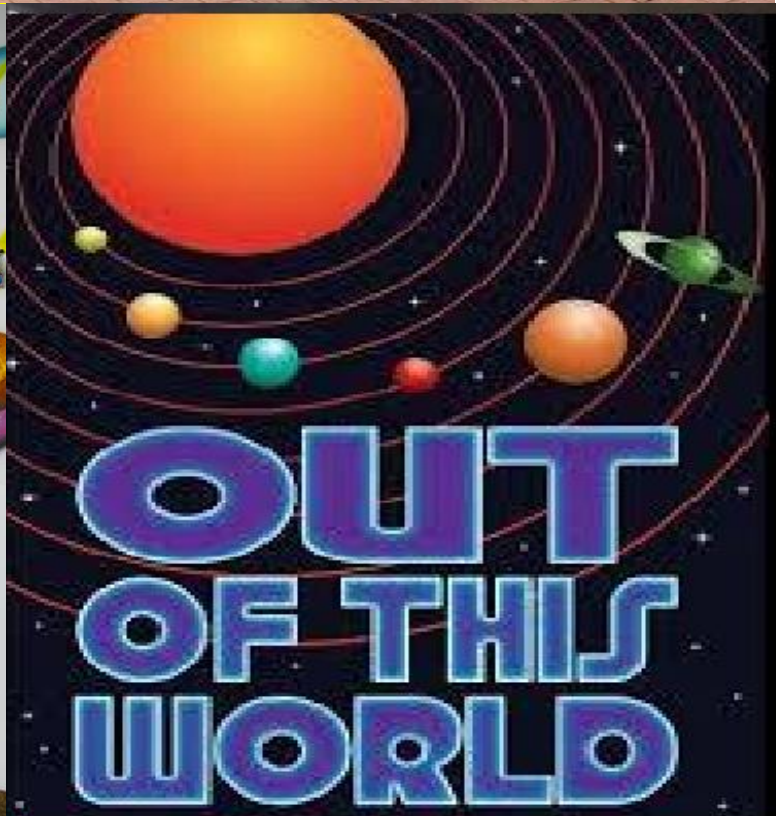

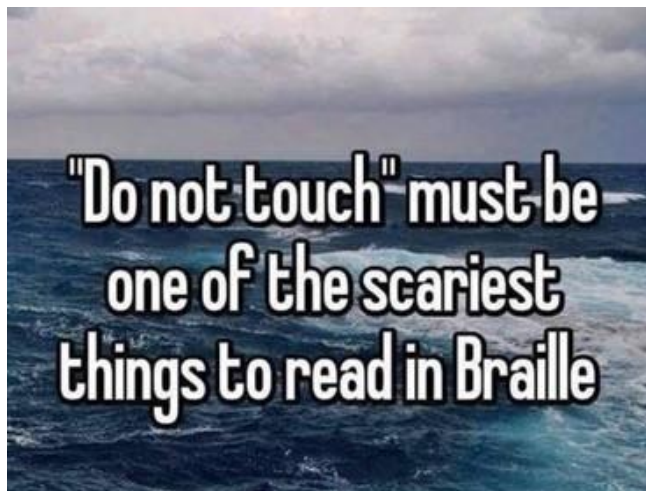

Goof ran quiz on alien topics to find the biggest sci fi buff. The waitresses chose the best dressed male & female.

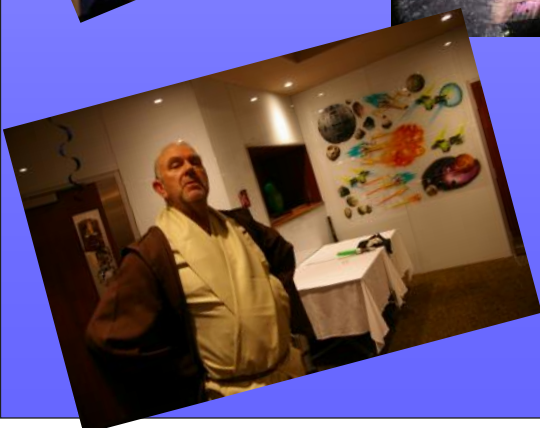
Female was won by Cathy McPhee (colourful alien)
