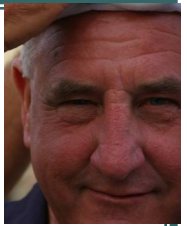

The startling feature is the electronic rear view mirror and blind spot monitoring system in the centre of the vehicle. 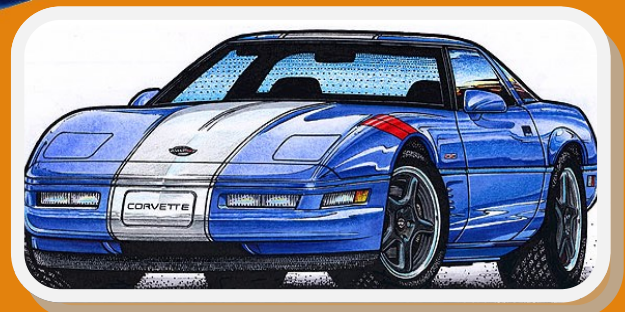
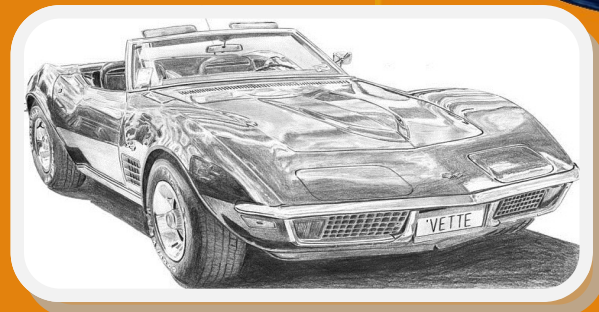

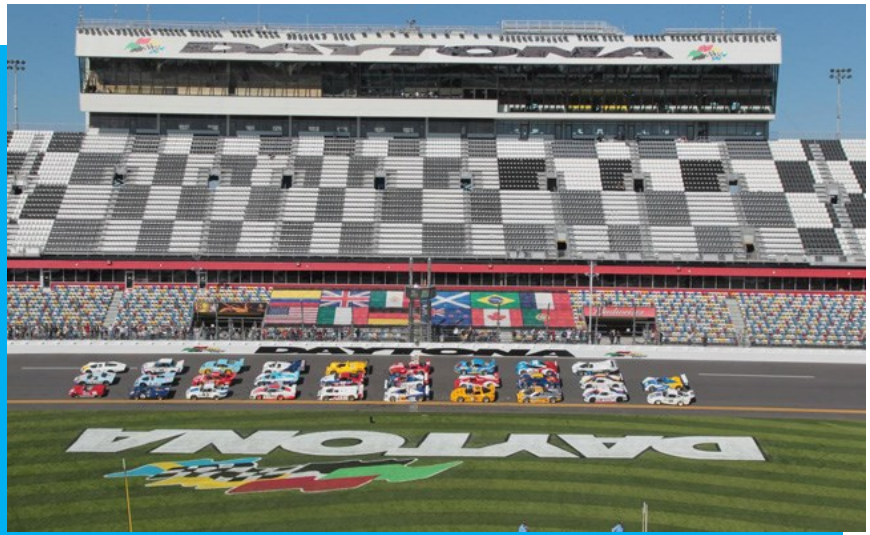

Corvettes in the Prototype class took out the top four positions in the inaugural Rolex 24 endurance race, at Daytona Beach, Florida. João Barbosa managed to hold off Max Angelelli to take the chequered flag by just 1.5 seconds after 695 laps in 24 hours.

The final few minutes became a sprint home after everything bunched up behind the pace car after a late caution period. Barbosa, who shared the Action Express Racing Corvette with Sébastien Bourdais and Christian Fittipaldi, had been ahead by about 10 seconds before that. Angelelli's co-drivers were Wayne Taylor and his sons, Jordan and Ricky. John Martin, Fabien Giroux and Brian and Burt Frisselle finished third.



Along with the prototypes three other classes competed in the event, which was the inaugural race in the new Tudor United Sports Car Championship, which merges elements of the previously contested Grand Am and American Le Mans series. A new Porsche 911 RSR took the GT Le Mans class win, finishing sixth over all. In the PC class an Oreca FLM09 took the honours, finishing in ninth place over all.



In the GTD class, it was a Ferrari 458 Italia, declared the winner more than four hours after the race ended after a post-race penalty against them was thrown out. The event was marred by a serious crash early on with two drivers, Memo Gidley, who was at the wheel of the pole-winning Corvette, and Matteo Malucelli, sent to hospital.

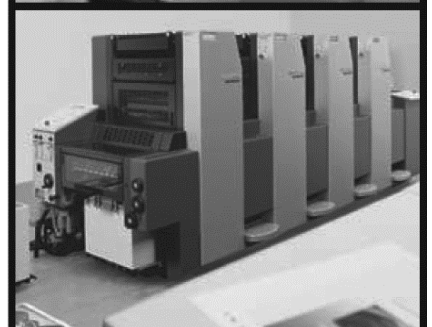

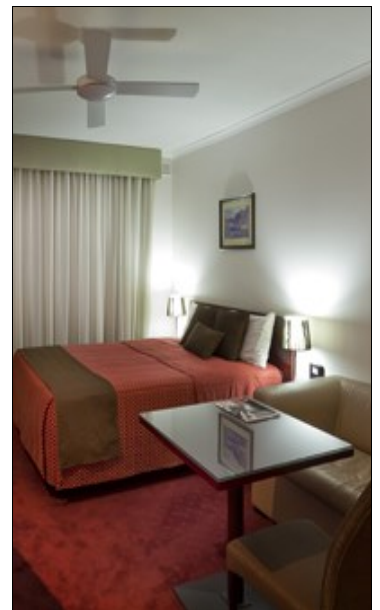
